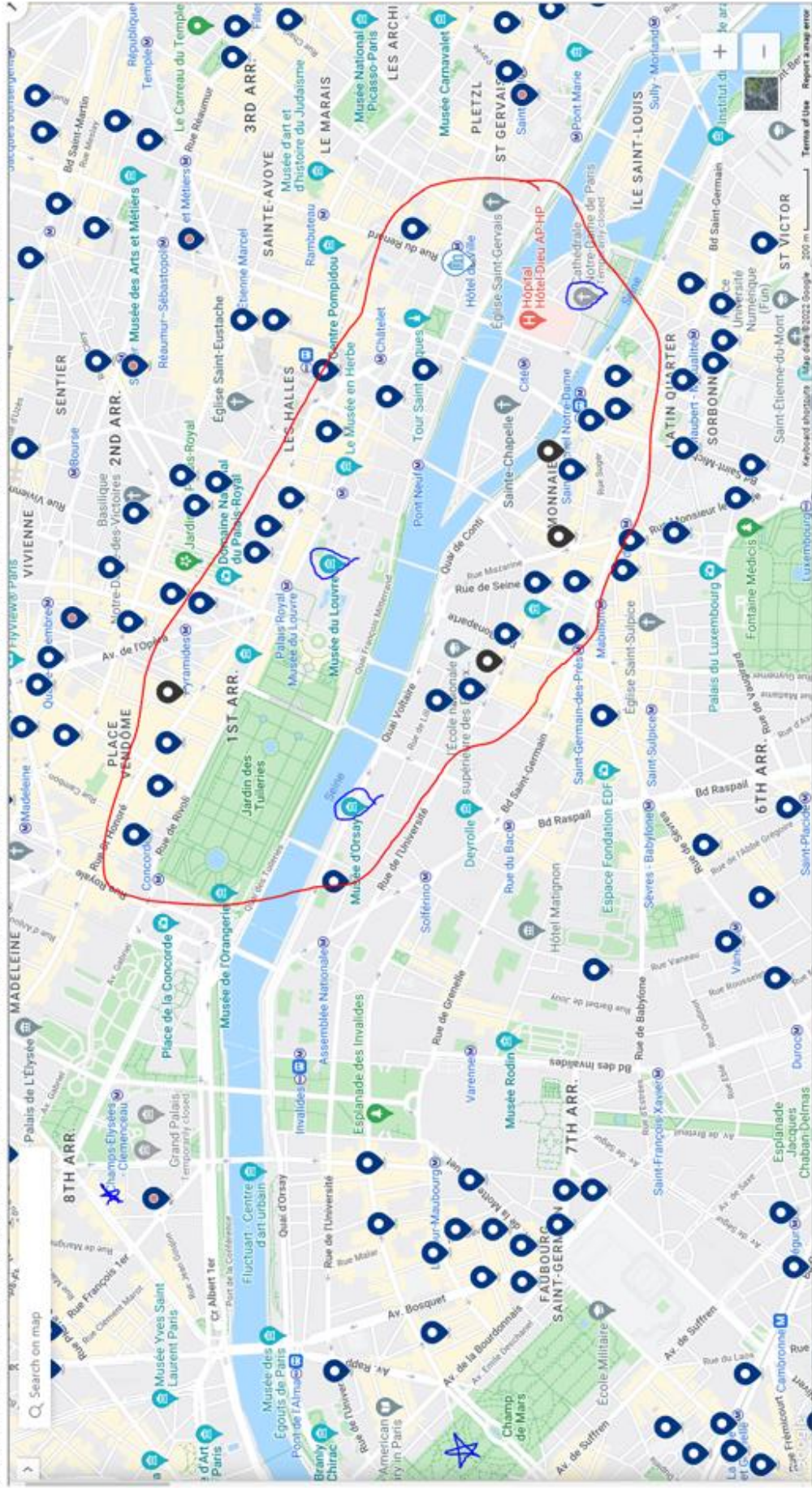
## How to find the BEST (for you) Hotel in Paris

In Paris, you want to try to stay on or near the Seine, (see the red circled area below) as there is a beautiful walking path all along the river that is magical – day and night – lots of street vendors, cafes and eateries - and you can walk to anywhere from that convenient location.

Use [www.booking.com](http://www.booking.com) to find a hotel that suites your style. Put in Paris; then add your dates; on the left hand side scroll down and select ‘Breakfast Included’ (yes you definitely want that); then hit Search.

Once the list of hotels comes up, THEN click on the upper right hand side, above the list of Hotels, “Show On Map”

This view gives you what is below, and you can roll your mouse over each dot, and the Hotel name and PRICE will POP UP. Very convenient. Then just click on the hotel to check the details and photos, and book. Or once you’ve selected the Hotel, you can go to their website (maybe they have a better deal?) and book direct!!



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
