- Scarlet macaws
- Iguanas
- Brilliant blue morpho butterflies
- Tiny red-eyed tree frogs
- Toucans right outside your hotel

Four very different ecosystems in one vacation. For photographers and nature lovers, it's a dream.

- Tropical Pacific beaches
- Active volcanoes
- Cloud forests
- Rainforests
- Coffee plantations

Very few countries let you experience so many distinct landscapes in such a short amount of time.

The cloud forests

Places like Monteverde Cloud Forest Biological Reserve feel almost magical. Moisture from the clouds sustains moss-covered trees, orchids, ferns, and an incredible variety of birds. Walking through the mist is unlike visiting a typical forest.

Arenal Volcano

Arenal Volcano is one of the world's most perfectly shaped volcanoes. Even though it's no longer erupting regularly, the combination of the volcano, rainforest, waterfalls, and natural hot springs makes the area exceptionally scenic.
